Program Research and Development

Researched the feasibility and developed a successful proposal for the creation of an outpatient indigent care program (St. Clare Health Clinic). This included definition of target population, demographic evaluation, data collection and interpretation, description of scope of care, standards of care, initial budgets, construction plan and plans for acquisition of medical equipment, furnishings and volunteers.

Northwestern Memorial Hospital Chicago, IL. 1983 to 1996

Resource Coordinator for Multiple Clinics: 1991 to 1996 Coordinated services provided by Prentice Ambulatory Clinics including: The Developmental Evaluation Clinic, High Risk Breast Clinic, Low and High Risk OB/Gynecology Clinic, Non-stress Testing Clinic, Colposcopy/Laser/Urodynamic Testing Clinic

Coordinated clinic schedules, cross-training of personnel, monitored day to day operations, supplies, repairs, and conflict resolution. I assisted in budgeting and quality management activities and I staffed clinics when needed.

Nurse Coordinator for Day One-Mid-life Program – concurrent with Resource Coordinator

Implementation and evaluation of a program directed at women age 40-60 years old. This encompassed comprehensive patient education and discussion of the medical and psychosocial aspects of aging, menopause, hormone replacement therapy, osteoporosis and appropriate preventative health care. I performed health status evaluations and health care planning including referrals and follow up care. I handled administrative coordination of physician coverage and ancillary departments and developed and monitored evaluation of patient opinion surveys and marketing. Both positions were located at Prentice Women's Hospital within NMH.

Nurse Coordinator - Assisted Reproduction Program. 1988 to 1991

I performed comprehensive patient education in relation to infertility and assisted reproduction. I also managed cycle coordination of patients, physicians, embryologists, and hospital/laboratory schedules. I performed follicular and early pregnancy ultrasounds and patient screening procedures and provided nursing coverage for artificial insemination and donor sperm programs.

I developed patient teaching information and materials. This position was located at the Northwestern Medical Faculty Foundation, affiliated with Northwestern Memorial Hospital.

Charge Nurse- Day Surgery 1985 to 1988

This position entailed planning, development, implementation and management of a ten bed outpatient recovery unit. The unit, one of the first of its kind at Northwestern, included pre-operative and post-operative patient care for out-patients. Additionally, the unit provided pre-surgical education and post-surgical follow up for both in-patient and out-patients of Prentice Women's Hospital including development of information and materials.

Charge Nurse - Gynecology-Oncology 1983 to 1985

I provided direct patient care on an in-patient primary care unit. Typical patients included surgical, chemotherapy and terminal patient care. Assumed charge nurse responsibilities including staffing, census/acuity management and assessment, coordination of ancillary departments and conflict resolution
